

# Fishing rules Camping 'Les 2 Lacs'

1. An unhookingmat of 1m x 0.80 m is mandatory.
2. A landing net of minimum 1m is mandatory.
3. No fishing with braided line.
4. Barbless hooks only.
5. The hooklink may not be stronger than the main line.
6. No fishing with fixed lead. The fish must always be able to rid himself of the lead.
7. You must have more than one keepnet/sack. The kept carp in at least 0.80m water and as short as possible.
8. The treatment of hookwounds and lost scales is mandatory with a suitable disinfectant. You may not mark or keep the fish.
9. No feeding with peanuts. Tigernuts are allowed but limited to 500gr per day.
10. Overfeeding can result in a 150Euro fine. Feed moderately, remember the water quality.
11. The caretaker may always check whether the necessary equipment is in order. You may be denied access if it is not.
12. Keep enough distance with your fellow fishermen. Be courteous. Choice of fishing spot is free.
13. In case of calamity call the caretaker.
14. Feedboats are not allowed in July and August. If you are stuck in an obstacle you may use the rowboats of the campsite.
15. Keep your fishing spot free of litter and restline. The costs of cleaning may be charged to you including the repair costs of mowers.
16. Night fishing is allowed. Fishing with more than 2 rods is allowed if the situation allows it with a maximum of 4 rods.
17. Never leave rods unattended, they have been known to disappear into the lake.
